We are swiftly approaching the end of the school year. The teachers thank the parents for their support during this time of learning for all. You have been a blessing to us and your child. There are some events that we want you to know about.

- All new assignments end by Friday May 15th. The teachers will use the 18th to the 22nd to work with those students that have work that needs to be completed. When the teacher says the student has all their work handed in, they are done for the year.
- 8th grade Graduation will begin at 7 p.m. on Saturday May 16th. The teachers will meet in the school parking lot at 7 p.m. and then proceed to the graduate's home where we will give them the diploma and a keepsake folder. You are welcome to join us in the school parking lot.
