<u>Regarding In-Person Worship services</u> – The latest executive order from Governor Walz has not changed in-person church service restrictions, just do so with caution. So why have additional Thanksgiving and Advent services? Because we need them to hear God's Word and prepare for His coming. Therefore, we will proceed with these services as long as it is safe to do so. Midweek services will not be recorded for cable and internet broadcasts. However, the plan is to prerecord the Christmas Eve worship service to be available by December 24 for YouTube streaming to our church family and visitors. While this will not be the same as being together inperson, we pray that it provides the Lord's blessing to those worshiping at home with the Scriptures and songs that celebrate the birth of the Christ child.

<u>Why can't we resume worship in the sanctuary?</u> We've been in the CLC for worship since mid-June and maybe you're tired of the setting; maybe missing the seasonal decorations that will not adorn the CLC since we share the space with the school during the week. We have two main reasons for remaining in the CLC: (1) The organ project is not complete. There are parts spread out under the balcony and the aisles, and there is nowhere else to store them, nor does the organ builder want us moving any equipment. Our target completion is the end of December. (2) We have no COVID19 preparedness plan for worship in the sanctuary. In order to be in compliance with the state, and thus be protected from lawsuits and prosecution, we must have this plan in place before we return. The Elders and Trustees will not have time to prepare this plan until January. Thank you for your prayers and patience. – *Pastor Augustine*
