For consideration at the April 25, 2021 Quarterly Voter’s Meeting:

This proposal would allow current part-time principal Rick Arguto to become a full-time principal at Immanuel Lutheran School. A full-time principal position would allow for more efficiency and effectiveness in the administration duties involved with the school’s ministry. This full-time principal position would also allow for more time to be invested in the promotion and marketing of Immanuel Lutheran School as we seek to grow our school ministry. In our search for a new candidate, we would also be trying to fill our need for a person to lead Immanuel’s school music program.
