A gift was designated to provide organ repairs that were needed on the instrument that was wearing out. The project evolved when the organ builder, Mr. Roland Rutz, secured an organ from Carleton College in Northfield, MN that was being decommissioned. For the same cost, Mr. Rutz offered to install this replacement organ which would have more options and better technology than what he could do with our old organ. We give glory to God and thank Him for the Vogt family gifts and the talents of Mr. Rutz that have provided this replacement organ to adorn our worship of God with beautiful music!
