**Current Brink Fund Status:** In 2013 we began the repair of the church exterior bricks. A Brick Repair Fund account was set up to raise the money necessary and a note was taken out at the bank. As of today, the current note balance needed to pay off the Brick Repair Fund is \$-<u>5,985.92</u>. Thank you for your support as we look forward to having this paid in full.

<u>Church stained-glass windows update</u>: An update on the Stained-glass window project was given at the September Church Council meeting by a representative from Willet Hauser, the company restoring the windows. It was noted that, due to timing and unpredictable factors, the windows will not be finished and installed until spring 2023. We will be provided with a current update and pictures of the progress being made on the windows to share with the congregation shortly. To date we have raised \$70,506.50. Total cost of this project is \$107,000. Thank you to everyone who has generously supported the Stain Glass Window Fund with memorials, donations, other fundraisers. We look forward to celebration when all is done in the spring!

<u>Update on financial status of church</u> At the end of August, net income for the church is <u>-65,383.45</u> Part of this deficit is due to this year's additional school staffing, insurance/benefits increases, and building maintenance. **Prayerfully consider a special gift** to Immanuel to help provide the resources needed to fuel this great ministry of Christ Jesus in our church and school. May the Lord reward your generosity with even greater blessings than you could ever ask or imagine (Eph. 3:20, Malachi 3:10)!
