2023 LCMS Synod Convention Action – Nominations

Every 3 years (although it is 4 this cycle due to COVID19), our church body, The Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod (LCMS), meets in convention to elect officers, discuss matters for the Church at-large, and review accomplishments since the last convention. At the next Voters meeting on January 29, voting members have the opportunity to nominate pastors for the positions of Synod President, Vice President, and the Regional Vice President. All congregations of the LCMS participate in this process. Pastor Augustine has the following suggestions for nominations. Two nominations can be submitted. If you attend the Voters meeting, you can bring forward additional name(s) then. Prior to the Voters meeting, please make your suggestion known to Pastor Augustine or Chairman Butch Mussell. Note: Per Immanuel's constitution and bylaws, voting members are communicant members that are 18 years or older and a member in good standing.

- 1. Synod President
 - a. Rev. Matthew Harrison Synod President, currently serving in that role
 - b. Rev. Lawrence Rast, Jr., currently the President of Concordia Theological Seminary, Fort Wayne, IN
- 2. First Vice President
 - a. Rev. Peter Lange for First VP, currently serving in that role
 - b. Rev. Benjamin T. Ball, currently serving as 6th VP
- 3. Great Plains Regional Vice President (covers Districts: Montana, Wyoming, North & South Dakota, Nebraska, Iowa District West, and Minnesota North and South; nominees must *reside in these districts*)
 - a. Rev. Nabil Nour, currently serving in that role; pastor at Trinity Lutheran Church in Hartford, SD
 - b. Rev. David Mumme, currently the pastor at Trinity Lutheran Church, Waterville, MN and First VP of the MN South District (He officiated PJ Aarsvold's ordination last June)

LCMS Presidential Voting takes place prior to the Convention in late July. Immanuel must elect a lay person to represent the congregation in this election process, which is all done online.
